

Welcome to the web portal for the education resources for parents of K through 12 migratory children. The Texas Education Agency in conjunction with education service in a region 20 have, created resources to assist parents in supporting their children's education at home. You can choose a preferred language, English or Spanish using the dropdown button on the top right of the web page.

Registering for access to the portal is easy. Simply click on the Register tab at the top of the web page, and enter the access code received from a district migrant education program, or MEP staff member. You'll be prompted to enter personal information. Please enter your first name, last name, and email.

You'll then create a password of your choice. Be sure it is one that you will easily remember. After entering personal information into the registration fields, click on Register. A confirmation email will be sent. When you check your email, please be sure to click the confirmation link within the email.

If a warning dialog pops up during this process, please click Proceed. If a confirmation email is not received, check the junk and/or spam folders in case the email went there. Once the email has been confirmed, you can log in and access the resources. After logging in, you'll be able to select a grade band by clicking on the appropriate grade band icon.

You'll have access to developmentally appropriate engaging mini-lessons, aligned to the state standards for each grade level. Once you click on reading or writing, you may view the PDF online or download it to your device. Mini-lessons include everything needed to implement, and are easy to use. You will also have access to tip sheets with embedded video vignettes for each grade band.

These tip sheets provide you with the background knowledge needed to implement the concepts addressed within the mini-lessons. A short video that shows the tip in action can be accessed by clicking on the link at the bottom of the page or by scanning the embedded QR code. An age appropriate mobile app is available for parents and children to download to an iPad or Android tablet.

The app includes multi-level games to practice the skills addressed within the mini lessons. The education resources for parents of K through 12 migratory children web portal will continue to expand, as more parental resources are developed. Our goal is to provide high quality resources that support children's academic growth, and feedback is crucial to ensuring this goal is met.
